“A dog must be registered with the American Kennel Club and documentation of AKC registration must be on file with Records to be eligible for Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club (USA) titles.”

Refunds:

Full refunds for scratches reported in writing prior to the drawing. After May 27, 2016, a \$25.00 scratch fee will be charged except for bitches in season or injured dogs when the scratch is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. No refunds will be given after the start of the test.

THE TESTS WILL BEGIN AT 9:00 AM

Running order will be determined by random draw the day of closing.

- NSDTRC-USA Ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying dogs.
- Ducks will be used on land and water.
- No training on the test grounds. Exercise/airing areas will be available.
- Alcoholic beverages are NOT ALLOWED on the Test Grounds.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

Breummer's Ranch, Port of Dewatto, WA – USA

DIRECTIONS from the TACOMA NARROWS BRIDGE/ VIA HWY 16:

- Through Tacoma on I-5 S near Tacoma Dome stay in the right lanes to exit onto HWY 16 Approximately 7 mi from Tacoma Narrows. After crossing over the Tacoma Narrows Bridge, stay on Hwy 16 traveling toward Bremerton. After you see the water inlet on the right you'll be approaching the Gorst area.
- From Gorst, take left-hand exit on Hwy 3 SOUTH towards Belfair.
- At the shopping center, (Safeway on right) take a right at the intersection and travel towards Belfair State Park.
- Take a right onto Sand Hill Road and travel approximately 5 miles.
- Take a left onto Bear Creek/Dewatto Road and travel approximately 8 miles to the end of the road.
- At the end of Bear Creek/Dewatto Road, take a left onto Dewatto Holly Road. Travel approximately 3 miles to the land test site.
