**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this test has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration for the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the test and of the opportunity to have this dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, and/or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, it's members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or Test Secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or things by the act of this dog while in or upon the test premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, damage or injury by caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

### NSDTRC(USA) WC/I/X Test Requirements - Tollers

The PHRC will offer a WC/I/X test for Tollers under the rules and regulations of the NSDTRC(USA). The judges have been approved by the NSDTRC(USA) field committee.

*NOTE: "A dog must be registered with the American Kennel Club and documentation of AKC registration must be on file with Records to be eligible for Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever Club (USA) titles. For dogs registered with AKC after May 1, 2000 that earn AKC titles and registration information is published in the AKC New Titles of Record Report, no copy of the AKC registration is necessary for club titles to be recorded; for dogs that earn a club field test title prior to any AKC titles, a copy of the AKC registration Certificate must be sent to Records for the title to be recorded"*

### PHRC Test Requirements - For All Other Retrievers

**WC** - Dogs must complete one land retrieve and two water retrieves to a designated area. Delivery to hand not required.

**WCI** - Dogs must come to the line off lead, must complete a land and a water double. Delivery to hand, not gun shy and on-lead honor is required. Decoys and boats may be used.

**WCX** - Dogs must come to the line off lead and complete a triple on land, a water double, land and water blinds and off lead honor. A diversion may be used. Decoys and boats may be used.

to all WC/I/X qualifiers!
